<p><b>3.1 Composition of Council</b></p> <p>3.1.1 The Council shall consist of not less than nine (9) and not more than eleven (11) directors who shall be Full Members of the Institute, other than Retired Members and Non-Practicing Members. Directors shall receive no remuneration for serving as such, but are entitled to reasonable expenses incurred in the exercise of their duty.</p> <p>3.1.2 Despite Section 3.1.1, of the directors of the Institute there shall be one (1) director who is a public interest representative holding no membership qualifications, privileges or office in the Institute but who shall be entitled to attend, participate and vote on matters before the Council.</p>	<p><b>(Change to 13 Council members)</b></p> <p>3.1.1 The Council shall consist of not less than <del>nine</del> <u>eleven (11)</u> and not more than <del>thirteen</del> <u>(13)</u> directors who shall be Full Members of the Institute, other than Retired Members and Non-Practicing Members. Directors shall receive no remuneration for serving as <del>such</del>, <u>but such but</u> are entitled to reasonable expenses incurred in the exercise of their duty.</p> <p>3.1.2 Despite Section 3.1.1, of the directors of the Institute there shall be one (<del>1</del>) <u>2</u> directors who <del>is</del> <u>are</u> public interest representatives holding no membership qualifications, privileges or office in the Institute but who shall be entitled to attend, participate and vote on matters before the Council. <u>There shall also be one Candidate Member or Student Member who holds potential full membership status qualifications and who is working towards their professional designation for a two-year term which shall not be renewable.</u></p>	<p><i><u>-Increasing the number of Council members provides us with greater opportunity to work towards our goal of a diverse and equitable Council. Adding a second public member and a Candidate or Student member, provides us with greater flexibility in Council make-up and ensures we have representation from the next generation of planners.</u></i></p>
