




Council Director Nomination Process

Every February, OPPI invites Council Director nominations from Full Members who wish to contribute to the planning profession by participating on Council. To learn more about the nomination process, please see our infographic below:

STEP 1: THE CALL FOR NOMINATIONS



If you are thinking about putting your name forward as Director, here's what OPPI needs from you:

- Three Full Members to endorse your nomination
- Fill out the Council Nomination Form, including a photo of yourself and your resume
- Fill out the Nominee Key Competencies Form

STEP 2: ARE YOU PRE-QUALIFIED?

You can expect a call from the G&N Committee to clarify your submission, go over Council obligations and outline the rest of the nomination process.

The committee also determines which candidates to pre-qualify to continue. If you aren't pre-qualified, the committee will let you know why and answer any questions you have.



STEP 3: INTERVIEW AND REVIEW

So far, so good - you're almost there! Now comes your interview with members of the G&N Committee.

The Committee will consider your profile, personal qualities and governance competencies. References will also be contacted.

The Committee will review your application and decide if you should be added to the recommended slate of nominees.



STEP 4: NOMINATION AND SELECTION



The Committee will notify you of their recommendation to OPPI Council. However, you can still put your name forward for consideration if you haven't been recommended.



A report is prepared for OPPI Council with a slate of nominees for OPPI's Annual General Meeting (AGM). This is sent to members as part of their AGM package to acclaim.



If there are more nominees than spots available, OPPI asks members to vote for nominees as part of their AGM package. The results are announced at the AGM.
